## ***PUBLIC NOTICE 5-1287***

**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** All interested parties are notified that the Commander, Fifth Coast Guard District has received an application from the firm of RK&K, on behalf of District of Columbia, Department of Transportation (DCDOT), for the proposed construction of foot bridges across navigable waterways of the United States.

**WATERWAY AND LOCATION:** Anacostia River Trail Bridges over three tributaries; Beaver Dam Creek and Tidal Gut in the District of Columbia, and an unnamed creek into Kenilworth Marsh, in Prince Georges County, MD.

**CHARACTER OF WORK:** The proposed project consists of the construction of three pedestrian bridges for the 3.9 mile Anacostia River multi-use trail along the east bank of the Anacostia River. DCDOT is also requesting a waiver of a bridge permit under Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 115.70; Advance approval for bridges. Advance approval waterways are those that are navigable in law, but not actually navigated by other than small boats. The Commandant of the Coast Guard has given advance approval to the construction or repair of bridges across such waterways.

### **MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES:**

#### **Proposed Tidal Gut**

Vertical: 5 feet at MHW

Horizontal: 10 feet  
(bridge's sound end)

#### **Proposed Beaver Dam**

Vertical: 5 feet at MHW

Horizontal: 10 feet  
(bridge's south end)

#### **Proposed unnamed**

Vertical: 1.5 ft at MHW


Horizontal: 6 feet  
(bridge's north end)

**SOLICITATION OF COMMENTS:** Interested parties are requested to express their views, in writing, on the proposed construction of the replacement bridge giving sufficient detail to establish a clear understanding of their reasons for support of or opposition to the proposed project. Comments will be addressed for the record at the office of Commander (dpb), Fifth Coast Guard District, 431 Crawford Street, Portsmouth, VA 23704-5004 through **March 6, 2013**. Location map and plan sheets are attached.





 December 2009






**Anacostia Riverwalk Trail**
