PUBLIC NOTICE (D8 DWB-868)

All interested parties are notified that an application dated April 21, 2016, has been received from the Minnesota Department of Transportation by the Commander, Eighth Coast Guard District, for approval of location and plans for the construction of the Redwing Highway Bridge Replacement Project over a navigable waterway of the United States. The existing bridge will be removed.

WATERWAY AND LOCATION: Upper Mississippi River, Mile 790.6, at Redwing, Goodhue County, Minnesota.

CHARACTER OF WORK: Construct a fixed two-lane bridge to replace the existing Redwing Highway Bridge, which will be removed.

MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES:

Horizontal: 421.0 feet measured normal to axis of the channel	Horizontal: 390.3 feet measured normal to axis of the channel
Vertical: 64.7 feet at main channel span above normal pool stage 666.64 feet m.s.l.	Vertical: 70.5 feet at center of span; 62.5 feet, 28 feet out from pier face above normal pool stage 666.64 m.s.l.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), lead federal agency, has approved on April 21, 2016 an Environmental Assessment/Finding of No Significant Impact (EA/FONSI). The Coast Guard has tentatively approved an EA/FONSI pending the Public Notice. The bridge is located in the base floodplain. The low steel elevation of the bridge is 729.1 feet, m.s.l. The project will require approximately 1,900 cubic yards of material to be excavated and 27,000 cubic yards of fill will be placed below the 100-year flood elevation of 683.72 feet m.s.l. The applicant has applied for a Water Quality Certification (WQC) pursuant to Section 401 of the Clean Water Act from the Minnesota Department of Environmental Protection. The existing to-be-replaced bridge is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places; a Section 106 Review of the project has been completed and was signed by the Minnesota State Historic Preservation Office on March 17, 2016, Wisconsin State Historic Preservation Office on March 4, 2016 and the FHWA on March 15, 2016. The project will not have a significant impact on threatened or endangered species, residential and business properties, minority and low-income populations or adversely impact Environment Justice.








GENERAL ELEVATION
