AMENDMENTS TO THE GENERAL PROVISIONS
ON SHIPS' ROUTEING

The Maritime Safety Committee at its forty-eighth session (MSC 48/25, Annex 24) adopted the following amendments to the General Provisions on Ships' Routeing (Assembly resolution A.278(X)) subject to confirmation by the thirteenth Assembly.

1 Section 3.5

Replace second sentence by:

"That date shall not be earlier than six months after the date of adoption of a routeing system by the Organization, but when new chart editions necessitate a substantially longer period between adoption and implementation, the Organization shall set a later date as required by the circumstances of the case."

2 Section 9.1, symbol 8

Replace "details" for symbol 8 by:

"8. Boundary of areas to be avoided, and explicitly defined limits of designated inshore traffic zones where not already defined by the adjacent traffic separation line or zone (6) (5)".
