## PRELIMINARY PUBLIC NOTICE (11-163)

The United States Coast Guard is soliciting public comments on a proposal by the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to replace the pier protection system at the existing Route 37 bridge across the Petaluma River. The General Bridge Act of 1946 requires approval of the location and plans for bridges over navigable waters of the United States, prior to commencing construction. This public notice allows the public to comment on the navigational clearances being proposed. A Coast Guard Bridge Permit application has not yet been submitted but would be required for this project.

<u>WATERWAY AND LOCATION:</u> Petaluma River, mile 1.0, near Blackpoint, at the Marin/Sonoma County line, California. 38.11577, -122.50537.

## PROPOSED MINIMUM NAVIGATIONAL CLEARANCES OF THE MODIFIED BRIDGE:

## **Existing**

Horizontal: 140 feet, measured normal to axis of channel

<u>Vertical</u>: 70 feet above Mean High Water (MHW\*)

## **Proposed**

Horizontal: 128 feet, measured

normal to axis of channel

Vertical: 70 feet above MHW\*

The proposed replacement fender system will reduce the horizontal clearance of the bridge by 12 feet.

\*Datum: MHW elevation of 3.15 feet, NAVD88.

#### **SOLICITATION OF COMMENTS:**

Mariners are requested to comment on navigational access and safety issues, including the need for clearance gauges and extended nighttime navigation through the bridge.

Commercial and recreational mariners in the project vicinity are requested to provide information about their vessels including type of vessel, length overall, draft, beam, and height from the waterline to the highest fixed point and to appurtenant structures (e.g. tuna towers, flying bridges, fixed antennas and radar units) and whether these appurtenant

structures can be disassembled, dismantled or lowered. Also provide where the vessel is primarily moored and the frequency of passage under the proposed modified bridge (i.e. number of times per month).

Interested parties are requested to express their views, in writing, on the proposed bridge modification project, giving sufficient detail to establish a clear understanding of their reasons for support of or opposition to the proposed project. 


